Constitutional Amendment A:

The Wyoming Constitution allows the state to invest state funds in equities such as the stock of corporations, but does not allow the funds of counties, cities and other political subdivisions to be invested in equities. The adoption of this amendment would allow the funds of counties, cities and other political subdivisions to be invested in equities to the extent and in the manner the legislature may allow by law. Any law authorizing the investment of specified political subdivision funds in equities would require a two-thirds vote of both houses of the legislature.

Constitutional Amendment B:

Currently, the Wyoming Constitution requires Wyoming Supreme Court justices and district court judges to retire upon reaching the age of seventy (70). This amendment increases the mandatory retirement age of Supreme Court justices and district court judges from age seventy (70) to age seventy-five (75).

SOUTH BIG HORN CONSERVATION DISTRICT TAX

"Shall the South Big Horn Conservation District continue to impose a conservation district tax, not to exceed one-half (1/2) mill, on all property within South Big Horn County for the purpose of providing soil and water conservation programs directed by the South Big Horn Conservation District?"
This question is to continue the tax which was approved in the 1992, 1994, 1998, 2002, 2006, 2010, 2014 and 2018 General Elections.

NORTH BIG HORN HOSPITAL DISTRICT TAX

"Shall the North Big Horn Hospital District be authorized to continue to levy an additional 3 mills as provided by W.S. 35-2-414 for a period not to exceed four (4) years, to provide sufficient funds for the continued operation of the hospital and nursing home?"

SOUTH BIG HORN COUNTY HOSPITAL DISTRICT TAX

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TOWN OF GREYBULL LODGING TAX

"Shall the Town of Greybull, Big Horn County, State of Wyoming, be authorized to renew the existing two percent (2%), upon the sales price paid for lodging services as defined under W.S. 39-15-204(a)(ii), the primary purpose of which is for local travel and tourism promotion?"

TOWN OF LOVELL LODGING TAX

"Shall the Town of Lovell, Big Horn County, State of Wyoming, be authorized to renew the existing two percent (2%), upon the sales price paid for lodging services as defined under W.S. 39-15-204(a)(ii), the primary purpose of which is for local travel and tourism promotion?"

Secretary of the District for Cemetery District Trustees, Conservation District Supervisors, Fire Protection District Directors, Hospital District Trustees, Senior Citizens Service District Trustees, Rural Health District Trustees

November 8, 2022 General Election Day

October 24, 2022 is the last day to register before the General Election. Election Day registration is available at the polls. Identification is required to register to vote. (Must have acceptable ID)

IMPORTANT REGISTERED VOTER CHANGE: All Wyoming voters are now required to show one of the following acceptable forms of ID when voting in person:

- WY Driver's License or ID Card
- Tribal ID Card
- US Passport
- US Military Card
- Driver's License or ID card from another state
- University of Wyoming or Wyoming Community College Student ID
- Wyoming Public School Student ID
- Valid Medicare or Medicaid Insurance Card

If you don't have one of these forms of ID, free ID Cards are available from your local Driver Services Office.

If you require assistance at the polls to vote by reason of sight impairment, disability, or inability to read or write, a person of your choice may give you assistance. If you have questions regarding the accessibility of your polling place, please contact Lori Smallwood, County Clerk.

IMPORTANT! This is for Candidates and Campaign Committees supporting county and municipal candidates. (W.S. 22.25-106)

Who must file?

Each candidate and candidate's committee (if applicable) is required to file campaign finance reports within the statutory deadlines, whether the candidate is successful or not; this is to include:

- Candidates who neither receive nor spend any money during the campaign must file.
- A committee formed before or after an election is required to file after each election.

What must be filed and when?

- A candidate/committee shall file an itemized statement of contributions and expenditures at least seven (7) days *before* the election.

Where do I file?

- **File:** Office of your local County Clerk.

What are the deadline dates for the 2022 election?

- **General Election:** Contributions & Expenditures – at least 7 days before Primary: **Nov. 1, 2022**

Penalty for not reporting:

A person found guilty of violating Wyoming campaign finance statutes is subject to criminal charges. Failure to file a required report could result in a two (\$200.00) civil penalty. WS 22-25-108(f).

ABSENTEE BALLOTS FOR THE GENERAL ELECTION

Absentee Ballots for the General Election may be requested at the Big Horn County Clerks Office. The ballots will be available beginning September 23, 2022. A qualified elector may apply for an absentee ballot either in writing, by telephone, by email or by fax. The absentee ballot will be mailed to the address given to the Clerk's Office.

The names of candidates will be rotated on the official ballots, starting with Basin, the first district established by the county commissioners with the rest following in sequence.
