

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS TO COMPLETE THE  
WYOMING VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATION BY MAIL  
DURING THE 30 DAYS BEFORE AN ELECTION

**IMPORTANT:** To register by mail (absentee registration) during the 30 days before an election, you **MUST ALSO** request and vote an absentee ballot.

1. The Voter Registration Application form and the Request for Absentee Ballot Application form can be printed online.
2. Complete items 1 thru 4: following all instructions on the Application. You must complete all **REQUIRED** information. Do not sign until you are in front of a notary.
3. Item Number 2: You must provide the number of your valid Wyoming Driver's License if one has been issued to you. Only if one has not been issued to you can you leave this off your application. If you do not have a Wyoming Driver's License, you must provide the last four digits of your social security number.
4. After you have completed the Voter Registration Application, take it to a notary, show identification (photo ID) to satisfy their requirement to establish you are who you present yourself to be.
5. Read the "Voter Registration Oath" and, in the presence of the notary, sign beside the arrow.
6. Have the notary complete and sign the next portion, including a notation of the type and number of identification shown.
7. Mail the Registration Application along with a copy of your Wyoming Driver's License, if one has been issued or other official photo ID if you have no Wyoming Driver's License to: Dori Noyes, Big Horn County Clerk, P.O. Box 31, Basin, WY 82410.
8. Along with the Voter Registration Application and copy of photo ID, complete and mail the Request for Big Horn County, Wyoming Absentee Ballot, according to instructions.

Upon receipt of the correctly completed application, you will be added to the Big Horn County voter registration list and your absentee ballot will be mailed according to your request.

**IMPORTANT NOTICE:**

You are **REQUIRED** to send a copy of acceptable identification with your Registration Application and Ballot Request before an absentee ballot can be sent. If you have been issued a Wyoming Driver's License, send a copy of it. If you do not have a valid Wyoming Driver's License, send a copy of another official photo identification document such as another state driver's license. According to the Federal Help America Vote Act of 2002, if you register to vote by **MAIL**, the first time you go to the polls to vote you will be **REQUIRED** to provide an acceptable identification document to the election official in order to vote, even though you showed ID in front of a notary when you completed the voter registration form.
