August 17, 2010 - Primary Election Day

July 19, 2010 is the last day to register before the Primary Election. Election day registration is available at the polls. Identification is required to register to vote.

If you require assistance at the polls to vote by reason of sight impairment, disability, or inability to read or write, a person of your choice may give you assistance. If you have questions regarding the accessibility of your polling place, please contact Dori Noyes, County Clerk.

CANDIDATE OR COMMITTEE TO FILE STATEMENT

All candidates, except Precinct Committeemen and Women, in the Primary Election, whether successful or not, are required by law, to complete the "Statement of Receipts Only" reports. The completed report must be returned to the County Clerks Office at least no later than August 10, 2010.

All candidates, except Precinct Committeemen and Women, in the Primary Election, whether successful or not, are required by law, to complete a "Statement of Receipts and Expenditures" report. The completed report must be returned to the County Clerks Office no later than August 27, 2010.

All candidates must return each report, regardless if you have receipts and/or expenditures (campaign contributions of any kind) or not. If you have no receipts and/or expenditures, you need to complete the candidate and office information on the first page, and checkmark the box next to no receipts and/or expenditures statement and sent that page only to the County Clerks Office. Be sure to sign each report!

Every Candidate Campaign Committee and every Political Action Committee shall file a "Statement of Campaign Receipts and Expenditures" by August 27, 2010.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS FOR THE PRIMARY ELECTION

Absentee Ballots for the Primary Election may be requested at the Big Horn County Clerks Office. The ballots will be available beginning July 8, 2010. A qualified elector may apply for an absentee ballot either in person, in writing, or by the telephone. The absentee ballot will be mailed to the address given to the Clerk's Office, if the ballot is not to be picked up by the elector.

The names of candidates will be rotated on the official ballots, starting with the first district established by the County Commissioners with the rest following in sequence. Therefore, the candidates will not always appear in the order shown on the sample ballots.
