SOUTH BIG HORN CONSERVATION DISTRICT TAX

“Shall the South Big Horn Conservation District continue to impose a conservation tax, not to exceed one-half (1/2) mill, on all property within South Big Horn County for the purpose of providing soil and water conservation programs directed by the South Big Horn Conservation District?” This question is to continue the tax which was approved in the 1992, 1994, 1998, 2002 and 2006 General Elections.

“Shall the South Big Horn Hospital District be authorized to levy an additional 3 mills as provided by W.S. 35-2-414 for a period not to exceed four (4) years, to provide sufficient funds for the continued operation of the hospital, ER and nursing home?”
