

TO REGISTER:

1. Must be a bona-fide resident of Big Horn County, which means the place where a person has a current habitation and to which, when he is absent, he has the intention of returning. There are no requirements for how long a person must live in the county before registering to vote.
2. At least 18 years of age on Election Day
3. U.S. citizen
4. Not convicted of a felony, or if so, has been pardoned
5. Not been judged "mentally incompetent" in a court of law
6. **Must produce acceptable ID** (compliant with Federal Help America Vote Act of 2002):

Acceptable forms of ID:

PREFERRED: Wyoming Drivers License AND last four (4) digits of your social security number. (Compliant with Federal Help America Vote Act of 2002)

SECOND CHOICE: Last four (4) digits of your social security number and one of the following photo IDs:

- a. Any state's driver's license
- b. ID card issued by federal, state or local government agency
- c. U.S. Passport
- d. School ID
- e. Military ID

THIRD CHOICE: Last four (4) digits of your social security number and two (2) of the following IDs in any combination:

- a. Certification of U.S. Citizenship
- b. Certificate of Naturalization
- c. Draft Record
- d. Voter's registration card from other state or county
- e. Original or certified copy of a birth certificate bearing an official seal
- f. Certification of birth abroad issued by The Department of State
- g. Any other form of identification issued by an Official Agency.

Complete Registration Oath Card. You must use your Legal Name and your Wyoming residence address. Wyoming residence is defined as: The place where a person has a current habitation and to which, whenever he is absent, he has the intention of returning.

Read the "Voter Registration Oath" and sign the document.
