August 16, 2016 Primary Election Day

August 1, 2016 is the last day to register before the Primary Election. Election Day registration is available at the polls. Identification is required to register to vote. (Must have acceptable ID)

If you require assistance at the polls to vote by reason of sight impairment, disability, or inability to read or write, a person of your choice may give you assistance. If you have questions regarding the accessibility of your polling place, please contact Lori Smallwood, County Clerk.

IMPORTANT! This is for Candidates and Campaign Committees supporting county and municipal candidates. (W.S. 22.25-106)

Who must file?

Each candidate and candidate's committee is required to file campaign finance reports within the statutory deadlines, **whether the candidate is successful or not**; this is to include:

- Candidates who neither receive nor spend any money during the campaign must file.
- A committee formed before or after an election is required to file after each election.

What must be filed and when?

- A candidate/committee shall file an itemized statement of contributions at least seven (7) days *before* the election.
- The candidate/committee shall file a statement of contributions and expenditures within ten (10) days *after* a primary or general election.

Where do I file?

What are the deadline dates for the 2016 election?

- **Primary Election:** Contributions Only – at least 7 days before Primary: **Aug. 9, 2016**
Contributions & Expenditures – within 10 days after the Primary: **Aug. 26, 2016**
- **General Election:** Contributions Only – at least 7 days before Primary: **Nov. 1, 2016**
Contributions & Expenditures – within 10 days after the General: **Nov. 18, 2016**

Reporting requirements:

The general rule is that a candidate/committee should note and keep track of all campaign contributions no matter how small. The law only requires you to itemize contributions on this form that total \$25 or more. However, keep in mind that if you receive \$10 from a contributor who then later gives you \$20, you must report the total \$30 contribution on this form.

Penalty for not reporting:

A person found guilty of violating Wyoming campaign finance statutes is subject to criminal charges.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS FOR THE PRIMARY ELECTION

Absentee Ballots for the Primary Election may be requested at the Big Horn County Clerks Office. The ballots will be available beginning July 1, 2016. A qualified elector may apply for an absentee ballot either in person, in writing, by telephone or by email. The absentee ballot will be mailed to the address given to the Clerk's Office, if the ballot is not to be picked up by the elector.

The names of candidates will be rotated on the official ballots, starting with Basin, the first district established by the county commissioners with the rest following in sequence.
