A detailed sketch or site plan must be attached to this application. The site plan needs to indicate the proposed construction location (where on the county road for which access is requested), and the access and drainage dimensions.

The Permittee hereby acknowledges and agrees as follows:

1. This permit grants permission for the Permittee to occupy a portion of the right-of-way controlled by the County for the purpose of constructing and maintain an Access Driveway. This permission is limited by the type of controlling interest held by the County. Responsibility to satisfy any other fee (deeded) interests rests with the Permittee.
2. The access driveway and drainage structure will be constructed and maintained in a manner to conform with Big Horn County Road Standards, Wyoming Public Works Standard Specification, applicable Federal, State or local laws, codes, and ordinances, in the location shown on the attached "Exhibit A", and as directed by Big Horn County. Constructing the access driveway and drainage in a location other than the originally approved without obtaining prior County approval by submitting a revised "Exhibit A" shall void the permit.
3. A plan sheet(s) labeled "Exhibit A", dated _____, is attached, which clearly shows the access driveway and drainage structure location, as well as dimensions from the proposed access to the roadway centerline and/or right-of-way line, which by reference is made a part thereof.
4. The profile grade of driveway(s) shall be constructed as indicated on the attached sketch or plan and shall in no case be graded or maintained such that water will drain onto the county road.
5. The permit will not be modified without the consent of Big Horn County. This permit does not allow for the installation of additional facilities, nor does this Permit set aside a strip of land of specific width for the exclusive use of the Permittee.
6. The Permittee agrees to forever indemnify Big Horn County and save it harmless from all liability for damage to property or injury to or death of persons, including all costs and expenses related thereto, arising wholly or in part or in connection with the construction, alteration, maintenance, repair, use or removal of the access and drainage structure by the Permittee or his agents, for those facilities located within the County Road system.
7. This Permit will be null and void if construction of the described access does not commence within 180 days of approval, unless prior arrangements have been made with the County Engineer specifying a construction period.
8. Any change in land use which would generate greater traffic volumes for this access would nullify this permit and a new application must be submitted.

9. Big Horn County reserves the right to inspect the access and drainage structure at the time of construction and at all times thereafter, and to require changes, maintenance and repairs as may be considered necessary to provide protection of life and property on or adjacent to the road at any time.

10. Any disturbance of the County road way will require additional permitting.
