August 16, 2022 Primary Election Day

<u>August 1, 2022</u> is the last day to register before the Primary Election. Election Day registration is available at the polls. Identification is required to register to vote. (Must have acceptable ID)

<u>IMPORTANT REGISTERED VOTER CHANGE:</u> All Wyoming voters are now required to show one of the following acceptable forms of ID when voting in person:

- WY Driver's License or ID Card
- Tribal ID Card
- US Passport
- US Military Card
- Driver's License or ID card from another state
- University of Wyoming or Wyoming Community College Student ID
- Wyoming Public School Student ID
- Valid Medicare or Medicaid Insurance Card

If you don't have one of these forms of ID, free ID Cards are available from your local Driver Services Office.

If you require assistance at the polls to vote by reason of sight impairment, disability, or inability to read or write, a person of your choice may give you assistance. If you have questions regarding the accessibility of your polling place, please contact Lori Smallwood, County Clerk.

IMPORTANT! This is for Candidates and Campaign Committees supporting county and municipal candidates. (W.S. 22.25-106)

Who must file?

Each candidate and candidate's committee (if applicable) is required to file campaign finance reports within the statutory deadlines, whether the candidate is successful or not; this is to include:

- Candidates who neither receive nor spend any money during the campaign must file.
- A committee formed before or after an election is required to file after each election.

What must be filed and when?

• A candidate/committee shall file <u>an itemized statement of contributions and expenditures</u> at least seven (7) days *before* the election.

Where do I file?

• File: Office of your local County Clerk.

(Note: Statewide candidates & candidate committees file online at https://www.wycampaignfinance.gov/

What are the deadline dates for the 2022 election?

- Primary Election: Contributions & Expenditures at least 7 days before Primary: Aug. 9, 2022
- General Election: Contributions & Expenditures at least 7 days before Primary: Nov. 1, 2022

Reporting requirements:

The general rule is that a candidate/committee should note and keep track of all campaign contributions no matter how small. The law only requires you to itemize contributions on this form that total \$100 or more. However, keep in mind that if you receive \$80 from a contributor who then later gives you \$30, you must report the total \$110 contribution on this form.

Penalty for not reporting:

A person found guilty of violating Wyoming campaign finance statutes is subject to criminal charges. Failure to file a required report could result in a two (\$200.00) civil penalty. WS 22-25-108(f).

ABSENTEE BALLOTS FOR THE PRIMARY ELECTION

Absentee Ballots for the Primary Election may be requested at the Big Horn County Clerks Office. The ballots will be available beginning July 1, 2022. A qualified elector may apply for an absentee ballot either in writing, by telephone, by email or by fax. The absentee ballot will be mailed to the address given to the Clerk's Office.

The names of candidates will be rotated on the official ballots, starting with Basin, the first district established by the county commissioners with the rest following in sequence.
